- Scott Roth-ELT Presentation-
  - His company, ARTEX, produces ELTs and he presented on the different types of ELTs for general aviation all the way to the 787 Dream liners. The provide ELTs to almost every airplane manufacturer. The military is also a big consumer of their products. He discussed everything from their design to their installment to their future inventions and overall uses. The import of the message was that old ELTs were inefficient, but the new ones are much better and reliable. Following the presentation, there was Q and A for about 30 minutes.
