A motion was made to elect John Luna as new Director of Promotional Activities for a 3-year term.

Discussion on Flight Hours

In 2002 the club flew over 4000 hours with 7 airplanes. These hours have been declining since then. The club has responded by reducing the size of the club's fleet. The future goal is to include a new training airplane, an LSA, to the fleet (like the Cessna 162 SkyCatcher) that also opens the possibility to earn a Sport License. The club has chosen to stick with an all Cessna fleet to provide an easy transition for student pilots. Projections for 2010 flight hours are at about 1130-1140 hours, which can be handled by 2-3 aircraft, but the club currently has 5 aircraft with one for sale.

The three members present voiced strong support for retaining a C152 in the fleet.

The President distributed the ballots to approve the sale of another airplane. **9 approved, 1 opposed**

The board and visitors discussed how to attract members and new members to the club, flying more, and promoting general aviation.
