Maintenance

August Maintenance:

1. The total maintenance bill for August was \$7323.10. This included a 100 hr inspection for N46439 (\$2721.92), an annual inspection for N66083 (3202.71), and a 50 hr oil change for N73146 (\$236.19).

Known Issues for September:

- 1. **N46439** had another 100 hr inspection, which should be completed by the time of the board meeting. A blocked pitot tube was cleared.
- 2. **N66083** will need a 50 hr oil change late this month or early next.
- 3. **N73146** had a complete ELT check after the FAA reported a possible ELT signal and sent the local sheriff to a grass strip in Washington, where our airplane was parked overnight. The check indicated nothing wrong with the ELT, and the battery was completely charged, indicating that the ELT signal was not from our airplane. This airplane also had a blocked pitot tube, which caused a failure of the air speed indicator. The airspeed indicator has been replaced and the system cleaned out.

Pitot tube covers have been provided for all OSFC airplanes.
