Miscellaneous issues

Routine reports

1) Maintenance

a. March maintenance summary

- i. **N46439**: Landing light wiring fixed(\$38.63)
- ii. **N73146**: Landing Light replaced (\$92.29), flap switch replaced (\$216.88), turn coordinator replaced (\$776.75). PPT switch on pilot's side replaced (\$188.72), miscellaneous (\$57.94). Total for March = \$1332.58.
- iii. **N6045W**: 50-hour oil change (\$170.51), possible oil leak was investigated [none found] (\$46.50), G300 system software was updated to version 6.20 (\$295.37). Total for March = \$512.38. Plus the following improvements: Rosen sunshades installed (\$223.25), battery minder installed (\$408.75)
- iv. **N66083**: \$0.

b. Known issues for April

- i. **N46439**: There will probably be an annual inspection done this month for the buyer as a condition of the sale.
- ii. **N73146**: 50-hour change was done in early April, the pitotstatic system and transponder were calibrated, and the display on the DME went out and was fixed.

- iii. **N6045W**: A Cessna Service Bulletin called for replacement of some bushings and inspection for elongation of some holes in the four rudder pedal arms. This is covered by warranty. CAS found that there was elongation and that the rudder pedal arms needed to be replaced as per the SB, but Cessna is not expecting the arms to be in stock until June (it would have been nice to know this before the rudder pedal assembly had been dismantled for inspection!), so the rudder pedal assembly was reassembled pending arrival of the necessary parts. There is no safety issue as the arms are still serviceable. Cessna indicated to me over the phone that all of this, including the double disassembly and double assembly, would be covered under the warranty if properly documented. CAS will handle this.
- iv. **N66083**: The system software in the G1000 was updated to version 0563.26 last week. This airplane will need a 100-hour inspection before 10 more hours of flight.
- v. Reimbursement request for \$471.67 for Dalrymple for headset, software for G1000, key blanks, drip pan, etc.: Motion McMurphy, 2nd Windom Approved 10-0-0
- vi. The question of placing a compass in 6045W was discussed but it was decided not to proceed.
